This study is intriguing, but, there are various enhancements that are required.

- 1. The topic is acceptable, but, it lacks a clear depiction of the impact exerted by both teachers and students.
- 2. The primary concern should be explicitly emphasised.
- 3. It is imperative to provide a clear and concise explanation of the sampling technique and procedure.
- 4. The instrument is satisfactory, however it should be further elucidated to provide a more comprehensive understanding of its content. The author references the instrument's citation. Alternatively, the author may independently develop it. Next, it is necessary to include a section on the validity and reliability.
- 5. The findings are clearly elucidated.
- 6. The discussion section should be thoroughly explored and analysed.
- 7. The conclusion should clearly delineate the areas for additional study.

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
