The authors illustrated the case of the tribal community of the "Lodha society" and demonstrated how women of such a community are experiencing many challlenges related to the discrimination and social injustice they are facing, starting withing their families... They also stressed the role of self-help groups in empowering women and boosting their self-confidence and their decision-making participation...
