Dear authors,

First, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to review this manuscript.

It is an interesting study about what AR Technology means in high school education—an experimental study that, through the questionnaire and the interviews used on the two groups of subjects, provides information on the involvement and the subjects' experiences regarding the use of AR Technology in the learning process. I appreciate the presentation of the research methodology used in this study, but I have some recommendations that the authors must consider in order to improve this article:

1. The introduction does not provide data on the current context of the issue addressed; it does not include studies from the specialized literature that address this topic.
2. In the discussion section, the presentation of the study results must be compared with other similar studies to highlight much better the contribution of the work in the field.
3. There is a need for more up-to-date references, particularly studies from the last 5 years (given that the most recent reference is only one, from 2013).
4. It is not clear how the points were obtained for each subject for the items of the two tests; this aspect should be specified.
5. There is a need to clarify the methodology of using AR Technology.
