The article holds potential and will contribute to the study field. However, the reviewer recommends that the article be revised and resubmitted based on the following main points:

- The title is problematic, and the abstract should be revised.
- No logical flow of ideas.
- Poor editing: poor sentence construction, spelling and grammatical errors, information is repeated.
- The author refers to and describes human trafficking; however, the focus is on the smuggling of refugees. These are two distinct actions, and the author should focus on human smuggling and not trafficking (based on the discussion of refugees entering the country illegally).
- Many paragraphs without any source reference(s).
- Poor discussion of the methodology.
