First of all, thank you for inviting me to review this article. This article mainly discusses the relationship between international student assessments (such as PISA and TIMSS) and psychometric intelligence tests (such as RAVEN) as well as the update of current average intelligence in various countries, but I feel that this article is not very standardized. Headings should not use periods. Headings use words that are better suited as keywords. There is no introduction, conclusion, or discussion in the text. The article describes at length the development history of intelligence measurement, without specifying the recent research status, and without review. The data presented in the table is not clear about what method or tool was used to arrive at it. At the end of the article, there is only a brief explanation of the changes in the intelligence level of each country, but no more specific discussion.

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
