A short review report about Acacia pycnantha gum is an interesting and informative document, but deals only with limited data, which would have been better presented in the form of at least two summarized tables and two good quality figures, including the chemical composition, phytochemicals, and bioactives of the gum, followed by food, pharma, and industrial applications. Recent in vitro and in vivo clinical trials conducted to find out the pharmacological potential of this beneficial gum are also missing from this review. The scientific writing style also needs uniformity. The number of citations may also be increased with some latest data.
