

Review of: "Effects of Teachers' Professional Development on Students' Academic Achievement"

It is an effective research which revealed new knowledge. The limitations are as follows.

First, the introduction is too long. It is suggested to separate the first part into two parts, i.e., Introduction and Literature Review.

Second, the proposition of research hypotheses needs to be based on evidence. Based on logical reasoning, realistic observation, or previous literature are valid.

Third, in the hypotheses, if the concepts "treatment group" and "experimental group" are the same one, I suggest to use the one wording.

Fourth, the section Research Design is a common sense, so I think it can be omitted.

Fifth, the contents of Testing the Null Hypotheses should be more brief. For example, the results can be displayed in one table.

Sixth, it is recommended that the results of the study be graphed to show how much effect the experiment has.

Finally, it is suggested to integrate the sections Conclusion and Recommendation into one section, focusing on four contents, i.e., research conclusions, theoretical implications, practical implications, limitations and future research.

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
