Dear author, the article has some structural problems, but the topic is interesting and relevant. About the structure, I will indicate what should be in each part of the text.

The objectives and results are not very clear; even at the end of the abstract, it should be clear what was most relevant to the research.

Article structure:

Introduction: discussion of the topic and a highlight of whether there is any difference from other acacias, and a clearer explanation of why gum arabic is important for use in the region, whether there is already local consumption by a community, or whether there is an industry in the region that processes this, or another justification that the author finds. The last paragraph of the introduction should state the research objective.

Methodology: better explain how the material was collected, whether there are authors of scientific articles who have used similar techniques, whether the quantity removed is the best for management (for example).

Results: compare data with the literature and carry out further analysis.

Conclusion: after restating the objective, you need to answer it in the conclusion.
