The data provided by the authors are of value, and they add to the existing current literature on the subject. The sample size is small: 191 patients. An important point: since we see a pandemic of caesarean deliveries (CDs), it would be of good use to look, by comparison, at the type of complications after CDs. Please comment on that in your Discussion section. The potential perianal complications associated with vaginal delivery might scare pregnant patients and push them to opt for a CD.

Introduction - it would be of value if you could include some references from the literature about other studies on the topic

In the Discussion section, please include limitations of your study. Please suggest ways to decrease perianal complications after vaginal delivery that are suitable for your population.
