Based on what was presented in the abstract, it appears to be well-structured and offer a good overview of the study conducted. However, the objective of the study should be clarified better.

The research objective is ambiguous and needs to be more explicitly stated.

Several definitions used in the article are unclear, and the authors could delve deeper into the topics related to the characteristics, sedimentation, and biodiversity of mangroves.

Additionally, adding various cartographic representations with clear labels could enrich and facilitate the readers' visualization.

Another suggestion would be to include a section outlining the study area and explaining the reasons for selecting it and its importance in enhancing research on the mangrove forest.
