The manuscript is well written, sound, and I do recommend it for publication as it is. I do agree with C. brasiliensis as the type species of the genus and believe the authors did a great job defending this position. My main concern is related to the validity of the network analysis using CytB. I expect to see a network analysis with faster markers such as the CR of the mtDNA, but this is not a big issue regarding the entire study. A second issue with this analysis is related to H8: TR02. It seems the sequence has accumulated mutations at a distinct rate compared to the remaining ones (maybe it could be discussed in the text).
