

Review of: "COVID-19: Health risk factors among students' population in Albania"

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Investigating the health risks to young people is a worthy and valuable topic. This is an interesting paper, however, there are many grammatical/language errors throughout which need to be amended as they distract from the overall credibility of the article. The sample size of 225 is small for a student survey and there is a very high proportion of female respondents compared to male. This gender imbalance is acknowledged but little discussion of why this occurred is offered. Perhaps the study should focus on female students only and this would permit a targeted investigation of the impact of the pandemic on female students. A lot of tables are presented, consider if they could be summarised and presented more clearly. The results (findings) and discussion sections should be separated. The findings should be more clearly stated in the abstract. Overall, the findings and discussion are very generic, you need to say why your study is important and how it contributes to academic knowledge. The discussion section should site your findings in relation to the body of academic endeavours to date.
