However, some minor changes have to be done;

- 1. In abstract (results section) instead of using methodology with <u>questionnaires</u>, <u>authors have to include the results</u> (<u>shortly</u>), <u>which is graphically explained in the text (results)</u>
- 2. Explaining the results of PAD test does not belong to discussion section, but it must be in the results section. Put one table with PAD test before and after the treatment in results
- 3. Authors have to explained the limitations of the study, and offer the next step forward (i.e. longer follow up three months is not enough for consistent conclusion
