I mention some of the my comments below:

- -Although the inclusion and exclusion criteria have been stated, the logic of their application is not clear.
- the authors should mentioned is this manuscript a secondary study or not?
- In the method part, the sample selection process is not clear.
- In the description of the instrument, the psychometric characteristics of the instrument are not mentioned.
- Most importantly, CFA is a part of a validation study and not all of it, a complete validation study includes several psychometric characteristics.
- This tool has been validated in 2012 so the significant of study is not clear.
