I believe that the work provides valuable information in the study of soil erosion in a basin with evident topographic contrasts. My main criticism is the scale of the study, since I consider that the pixels chosen are too large for the extent of the basin. In the same way, I believe that the subbasins should be studied separately and then integrated to obtain information related to land use. Finally, it is necessary for the authors to standardize the use of USLE units and graphics as proposed.

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
