Inconsistencies in naming conventions, such as the abbreviation for "Support Vector Machine," should be addressed. The results from the experiments and the contents of the tables and figures should be discussed in more detail. Lastly, the manuscript would benefit from thorough proofreading to ensure clarity and accuracy. Overall, the research is commendable and holds significance in its field.
