the statement "As a complex concept that represents a subtle deviation from established electoral procedures, electoral irregularities manifest in various forms as government interference meant" - is it only government that interferes? - what of the interference from politicians that are not in government?

last sentence. "The study is expressed in categorical variables in which chi-square is used for association analysis to ascertain the suppressing effects of lethal election violence on voter participation" - You have to remove this since you did not use chi-square analysis anywhere in the work.
