Dear authors, I really enjoyed reading your paper, I can see the hard work behind it. The literature review is adequate and the conclusions are important on a practical level as well as on a theoretical one. Although, I think there are some things that could be improved. Below are my suggestions:

Introduction

- There is so much content that it is hard for me to read what the author wants to say. I suggest streamlining the word count and expressing the main point.
- While the main goal is clear, I would recommend including some specific objectives and/or research questions.
- This section lacks a contrast with previous studies. Theoretical contributions are missing.

Academic Background

- I suggest adding a transition sentence between paragraphs, and the transition is too abrupt.

Strategies for Entrepreneurs to Deal with Risk

- This section quotes too much news and suggests a streamlined presentation.
- I cannot see a real discussion comparing the results with the previous literature. A real discussion must be included.

Discussion and Conclusion

- This section must provide a final view of the article by answering the research questions or specific goals.
- I think the proposal should start from the conclusion of the article, rather than make some general suggestions.
