This is an interesting article. Thanks for the opportunity I had to read it.

I would like to make some small remarks that can eventually be useful.

1. Title: The Young Pioneers of Cuba. I cannot see the relation of this part of the title with the contents.
2. "The article also compares civic education in Cuba with the progressive Critical Global Citizenship Education" (p. 1). Also repeated on p. 6.

It does not look like a comparison. The analysis developed is not a compared one. I suggest simply considering the CGCE as a theoretical framework to discuss the data (as it is effectively used in the discussion section).

3. Introduction: The article needs a clarification about the concept of ideology being used.
4. Findings: (p. 6) the article shows examples of the "alignments" but there is a lack of examples of "disparities". It would be fruitful to add.
5. "subtle influence" (p. 10). The article shows it is not subtle but explicit.
6. Clarifications are needed about the ways and meaning of this idea: "to receive Critical Global Citizenship Education (CGCE) in Cuba" (p. 12).
