Discussion

It was mentioned that "22.6% of children were considered as not having an acceptable dietary score". It was food diversity score in fact. Please correct it.

There was a paradox in the results of children 0-60 and children 61-20 months regarding their mothers' occupation. Mothers with children 0-60 who were housewives or worked in the private sector were more at risk of being stunted when compared to those whose mothers were small business owners. However, the proportion of 61-120 children who were malnourished was significantly higher among mothers who were business owners (28.6%) compared to housewives (25.0%), (p = 0.042). Would you discuss about this paradox? Why being housewife is a risk factor of malnutrition for younger children while it is not so in older children?
