It is well written and really adds to the information and contributions in the fields of education and technology. Here are some comments and suggestions to make the writing even better:

Abstract. In the abstract, you should write the research methods used and what the limitations of the research are, as well as recommendations for future research.

Introduction. Good. However, in the introduction section, you should add some relevant research that is consistent with the goals or statement of the research problem.

There is no methods section. In my opinion, it is better to add a methods section to make it easier for readers to understand the general description of the research methods and processes used.

Discussion. This section is best used to explain why all situations (7) appear in the Mid-Term Evaluation section, while not all situations appear in other sections.

References. Should be added.
