In the abstract, what is written as "objective" is not really an objective of the paper. Please rewrite.

All units of measurement should be written with their symbols (e.g. ha per hectare).

In the Introduction, some statements should be confirmed or reinforced by bibliographical citations. For example:

- -"...are also causing environmental degradation".
- --...and increasing the risk of wildfires".

At the end of the Introduction you have written some results or conclusions ("The results showed..."). This cannot be so.

There cannot be results and discussions in the introduction. At the end of the Introduction section you should write the aims of the work, justification of the research and why it is novel.

In the entire Material and Methods section, the wording must be improved.

Figures 1 and 3 do not look very good. Figures 2 and 5 to 11 I recommend that they be changed to 2D graphics, not 3D.

The symbol for tonne is "t" or "Mg" (megagram).

"Melaleuca", if it is a scientific name, should be written in italics.

All equations must be written with the equation editor.

Chemical formulae must be written correctly: P2O5, NH4+, K2O (3 times) with subscripts.

Please correct the typos: "Froest", "diametr" and "thicness".
