

Review of: "Retinal Vasculitis Following COVID-19 Infection: A Systematic Review"

The systematic review addresses an important point; however, the following points have to be taken care of:

- 1. Only 1 database was searched, and that was about seven months back. It would be better if at least one more database were searched, and research to a later, nearer date could be carried out. The results can be easily included as only case reports/series are included and no meta-analysis has to be done.
- 2. Write the full form of all terms used when used for the first time, e.g., OCT and FFA.
- 3. Correct numbers in the flow chart, e.g., from 101 initial studies found, 87 are shown to be excluded due to various reasons in the first step, which leaves 24 studies, not 14, in the next step.
- 4. The comorbidities of the cases are not mentioned. If that can be included, it can give another insight as to whether more affections are seen in those with comorbidities.

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
