The topic reported by authors is interesting, however the paper lacks structure and consistency.

Even if the text is short, it is not very easy to follow.

- a. The abstract is very short and do not describe what is reported below.
- b. The authors describes "new treatments implemented", however the papers reported presents only *in vitro* data. The research is still very far from considering those drugs as "possible treatments for dengue". Besides, the treatments are only rapidly described and are not enough data are presented to support their *in vitro* validity.
- c. This Research note is all based on the research of a single group, which limits the validity of the investigation. More references are needed in order to confirm the hypothesis stated.
- d. About half of the note describe traditional treatments of dengue as well as methods of vector control. A topic indeed interesting, but not in scope of the paper.

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
