This is an interesting but confusing article. Understanding the purpose of transportation APP selection seems like an interesting topic, but what is the purpose? Much is said in the article, but it is still not clear what benefits the results can bring to the practical work. As for the content, there are a lot of unclear points, including: What is the specific plan of the survey? What is the distribution of the sample? Sometimes a mismatch in the distribution of samples will lead to a bias in the results, resulting in unrepresentative results. How are the specific questions designed for the survey? The questionnaire is recommended as an appendix. What is the innovation of the paper? Did you study a particular area? Taking a novel approach? Or did you come to a conclusion that no one knew? It is clear that no innovation is seen in the methods and conclusions, and the purpose of studying this problem is not clearly stated. I think if the authors want to gain the recognition of readers, they need to supplement and improve the above problems.
