

Review of: "Misdiagnosis of Dengue Fever as Malaria and Typhoid Fever and Their Co-infection in Rural Areas of Southwest Nigeria"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

I have read the manuscript and wish to comment as follows:

- 1. The title is misleading and should be restricted to co-infection of Dengue with malaria and typhoid.
- 2. The grammar usage could be much improved, e.g., malaria and typhoid samples should be malaria and typhoid positive samples, etc.
- 3. Key words should include dengue, malaria, and typhoid.
- 4. *Salmonella* serotypes such as typhi and paratyphi should always start with an uppercase letter and NOT be italicized. *Plasmodium*, *Flavirus*, etc., are generic and should be in italics.
- 5. Section on inclusion criteria is bogus and does not include exclusion criteria.
- 6. Discussion should be streamlined, and there is no basis for comparison with the Netherlands.
- 7. Nevertheless, the study provides additional useful information on co-infections of dengue with malaria and typhoid.
