1. Since Stacey SK. and McEleney M. (2021) listed some topical corticosteroids in more than one potency class based on their formulation, additional explanation of the different formulations such as ointment, cream, lotion, and gel in the background section is recommended.
2. Although treatment of TSW is unclear and need further investigations, it would be helpful for readers to include in more detail on the suggested pharmacotherapies (calcineurin inhibitors, analgesics, tranquilizers, pregabalin, amitriptyline, dupilumab, oral antibiotics, antihistamines, and tranexamic acid), laser, and so on.
