Authors have presented a well-structured article emphasizing "In-Vitro Antibacterial Activity of some *Ganoderma* Species: A Review". In my opinion, the manuscript can be published in this journal after the authors have addressed the following comments and questions:

- 1. The author needs to revise the Abstract (last portion).
- 2. There are many typological errors in the MS; I recommend reading the entire MS carefully and correcting it where necessary.
- 3. I suggest creating a table related to *Ganoderma* species, outlining their respective modes of action, target sites, and the specific products responsible for inducing antibacterial activity.
- 4. The author has forgotten to write the title of Table 1. I suggest reading the MS carefully and correcting it.
- 5. The author needs to italicize the gene throughout the MS.
- 6. The author needs to dually check the journal guidelines. For example, references should be properly arranged. Please see Bacallao-Escudero et al. (2023), among others.
- 7. Draw a table of the Antimicrobial Activity of *Ganoderma* Species against Gram Negative Bacteria too.
- 8. Elaborate on the mechanism of Ganoderma species and explain it using a suitable diagram with a proper legend.
- 9. Add future prospects in the conclusion section.
- 10. The author did not follow the journal guidelines while preparing the MS; I recommend reading it and arranging the revised MS accordingly.
- 11. Additionally, the author should incorporate continuous line numbers, along with page numbers, to facilitate convenient commenting.
