

Review of: "A Bibliometric Review of CSR in China Based on CNKI Database: 2006-2022"

The objective of the paper is to identify and analyze the scientific literature in the CSR field in China with a bibliometric analysis.

The research paper relies mostly on identifying keywords in the CSR filed, but neglects to identify the most influential researchers/cited authors, the most cited references/sources/scientific journals, and the most cited research institutions/universities in the field. A lack of knowledge of prestigious articles or influential researchers should not allow the scientific community to become more knowledgeable about the research trends in the CSR field in China.

The analysis units should also include authors, research papers, journals or resources, research institutions or universities in addition to keywords.

The study does not define in more details the bibliometric analysis and explain its importance compared to previous studies' methods (e.g., meta-analysis and systematic review).

Finally, author should also highlight more its contribution relative to the existing literature. It is not clear whether the paper is the first analysis that uses a bibliometric approach to identify and analyze the scientific literature in the CSR field in China. If not, author should explain how the paper contributes to the existing literature.
