

# Review of: "The Strategy of Russia in the Trans-Eurasian Connectivity"

The article is well-written, and the topic is important. However, there are some minor revisions needed in the English, as there are a few typos throughout the text (e.g., "the Russian economist" instead of "a Russian economist," or "very" instead of "vast," etc.). Additionally, the author should aim to reduce the excessive use of acronyms, as it makes the text difficult to read.

Regarding the content, my concern is that towards the end, the author admits that the INSTC may not be feasible due to political contrasts in the area. The author should provide a more robust argument to support this point. It would be helpful if the author could provide more information on the current situation, indicating where development can be expected and where it is unlikely.

In general, the article provides a useful overview of the geopolitical situation and the infrastructure transport initiative in the Eurasia area. I recommend accepting the article once the above suggestions have been implemented.
