

Review of: "A brief overview on COVID-19 and its comparison with SARS, MERS, and H1N1"

The author conducted a good narrative review on an overview of COVID-19 and its comparison with SARS, MERS, and H1N1. In order to make this manuscript more attractive to scientific readers, some edits are required, as follows:

Q1: The grammar is incorrect. For example, in the sentence "The coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a global pandemic infectious disease with higher potential for outbreaks than the other epidemic disease such as severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS), influenza A (H1N1), and the Middle East respiratory syndrome (MERS), which identified in China on December 31, 2019", the use of attributive clauses is incorrect. Besides, "other epidemic disease" should be revised to "other epidemic diseases". In addition, in the sentence "Regarding themechanism action of 2019-nCoV, some researchers suggested that the ACE2 is the receptor of this novel virus", "themechanism" should be revised to "the mechanism". Please carefully check the grammar of the entire text and make corresponding revisions. (Abstract section) Q2: The Introduction section mentions "...... and treatment of the novel coronavirus disease, as well as clinical features of patients infected with COVID-19". However, the following section lacks the content of "treatment of COVID-19". Please add it.

Q3: In the Introduction section, the sentence "Moreover, the COVID-19 has comprised of severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS), influenza A (H1N1), and the Middle East respiratory syndrome (MERS)" is expressed incorrectly, COVID-19 should be compared with SARS, H1N1, and MERS, instead of comprising SARS, H1N1, and MERS. Please revise it.

Q4: It is suggested that the author switch the order of parts "Clinical features of COVID-19" and "Epidemiological parameters".
