2. The abstract lacks methodology for the study and real result values.
3. There are no keywords.
4. ...typically of grade 425 or slag cement... in the introduction is wrong. The "425" should be written as 42.5.
5. The introduction makes reference to results of studies without providing sources for those studies.
6. The introduction lacks direction and flow.
7. No literature gap(s) is/are established in the introduction that necessitates the current study.
8. The source of table 1 is not provided.
9. The introduction should be rewritten.
10. The experimental work is poorly described without any standard guiding the process.
11. The contents of Tables 2, 3, 4, and 5 are not compressive strength results as captioned.
12. The Conclusion lacks substance.
13. A lot of grammatical errors.
14. The list of references is not cited in the text, and most of them are not current.
