

Review of: "Knowledge of Risk Associated with Exposure to Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances in Abuja, Nigeria"

Manuscript of Okudo and Sunday Nicholas is of interest because PFAS compounds are persistent and widely used in America and Europe, but in Abuja, Nigeria, information on their use and importance is not known.

The study evaluated knowledge of PFAS in Abuja and highlighted the hazards of exposure to PFAS. The results revealed that only 9% of the population interviewed has knowledge of PFAS and its associated health risks.

A comprehensive study and awareness program on PFAS is recommended by this paper, and industrialized nations are asked to provide support and collaboration towards programs that will ensure sustainability.

The study would benefit from a more comprehensive elucidation of the research.
