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After a thorough review of this article, some of the suggestions/findings are mentioned below

- The article contributed well to the body of knowledge.
- Technically, the article is moderate; it needs to provide justification for the proposed mhMCR method with the existing approaches like NLP/LLP-based techniques
- The authors presented the subject matter in a comprehensive manner.
- The mentioned 11 references are relevant, but they are not well formatted and are not sufficient.
- It would be better to review at least 5 to 6 articles from the last two years' publications, which may help in knowing a few more existing approaches like NLP and LLP-based approaches other than what you considered.
