The authors have made a good attempt at summarising severe cutaneous drug reactions. Many reviewers have asked for a clarification on the study design. That this is a literature review and not a systematic review should be mentioned in the article. Drugs reactions are an extremely important subject in Dermatology due to their vast spectrum and ability to mimic almost all known dermatologic disorders clinically. The study has not discussed mechanisms comprehensively as promised in the title of the study.

Grammatical review is essential as emphasised by B Maharani. Results are not discussed in the main paper at all. The authors must provide results as a summary of the various articles reviewed in tabular form and report any deviations from general knowledge.

The first 3 clinical images do not have legends as to type of rash or the drug causing them. Databases like vigifarmaco and others should be included in the discussion and not directly in the conclusion. Conclusion is abrupt and does not seem to address the objectives of the study. The study quality can be improved by addressing issues raised by the reviewers.
