The work contributes to knowledge; however, there are a few points for correction.

1. The language needs to be more concise. The sentences are too wordy and could be put more succinctly. I suggest it goes through a language edit.
2. Students are basically learners in a higher institution. I suggest that this group of participants be referred to as pupils.
3. Children don't give consent; rather, they give assent (if older than 7 years). Their parents give consent. The school and ministry give approvals for the study. Pls correct this.
4. Table 1: The nutritional indices should have been represented by categories of Z scores (HAZ, WAZ, BAZ), i.e., <2SDs, -2 to +2SDs, >2SDs, not the mean Z scores.
5. The educational / socioeconomic status of the parents should have been more aptly represented in a table.
6. The conclusion is too long.
