The work conducted by the author is very interesting and generated important knowledge in the field.

Authors need to pay attention to the writing pattern of the abstract.

**Abstracts** should start with the importance of the study, objectives, methodology, results, and end with a conclusion.

From the **Introduction**, the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nd paragraphs are well written, but the last para should be improved with respect to highlighting the gaps in knowledge, and then to fill those gaps, the designed objectives should be clearly mentioned.

In the **methodology** section, well written.

In the discussion section, relate each result by adding previously reported work. **Results** are well written.

**Discussion** should be brief. I suggest making comparative studies and shortening it to 2-3 paragraphs.

**Conclusion** could be rewritten in 3-4 sentences, and further information could be added as future recommendations.
