It's an engaging and exceptionally timely piece. However, there are a few areas that require clarification to enhance readers' comprehension:

- 1. You mentioned that pre-baseline was not possible, yet you did measure their baseline.
- 2. There is an observed change in the control group's well-being scores, but the reasons for these changes are not explained.
- 3. Were any programs conducted for the control group members, or were there no programs for them? This requires further explanation.
- 4. For Table 1 (Demographics), consider adding clear lines or spacing to separate the groups, making it easier for readers to navigate.
- 5. Table 2 can be challenging to decipher, particularly in terms of how the 19% mentioned in the text corresponds to the table. Additionally, clarify the significance values in the paper, including the column used for reference.
- 6. While you mentioned the 14 WEMWBS Tool's sub-scale and their overall summary, the empirical values are missing from the article.
- 7. After Figure 4, the paper predominantly describes findings, but empirical data to support these claims is absent.
