

Review of: "The Ancient Indian Knowledge System and the Medical Sciences"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

Interesting article, certainly innovative. However, here are some comments:

- The Abstract could be divided into small subsections to improve reader readability.
 Improving the exposition of the aim of study and what methods were used to "justify the concepts of ancient Indian medical sciences" is unclear.
- Better explain the concept of nadi pariksha and E-HEALTH ANALYSIS in the Introduction paragraph, insert a definition.
- Increase the bibliographic references, the study appears to be poor in citations.
- It is necessary to number the tables or images in chronological order or report them in the text as (tab. 1) if necessary.
- The paragraph "Attributes of Mind According to Ancient Medical System" is not clear, also in the paragraph it is marked "Here are a few examples [5]." Are they referring to the citation reported as number [5]?
- Overall the article is distributed well, I would recommend inserting the numbers in the paragraphs or sub-paragraphs to improve the reader's understanding of the text, as some paragraphs appear to be connected and not in their own right.

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
