The article deals with a topic that is very current and tending to be of increasing importance. In addition, the amount and evolution of research in China also justify the interest in carrying out a bibliometric analysis on the CSR topic in the context of Chinese publications. The analysis is interesting and contributes to the area, although, as the author mentions in future studies, it would be more relevant if more analyzes were added, such as those related to citations. I also emphasize the need to review the abbreviations, namely the abbreviation "CSR" since it is used in the abstract and at the beginning of the introduction and is only indicated in full in the middle of the introduction. It will also be important to explain the reasons that justify the delimitation of the time period.
