## GENERAL COMMENTS

This paper focuses on the role of socio-economic conditions of parents on the personality of Christian teachers in Tambaksari District, Surabaya. The topic is interesting, since the relationships among the study variables are unique, especially in Sri Lankan sample.

## SPECIFIC CHANGES TO ATTEND TO

1. In the abstract, the authors need to mention clearly the characteristics of the participants, information about proportion of female and male participants, the Mean age, and SD age of the participants. The authors needs to make the abstract simpler by using 150 – 250 words.
2. In the Introduction, the authors need to explain the how their underlying theory is related to their hypotheses. This study seems to lack of a cohesive, unifying theoretical framework.
3. In the Introduction, the authors need to strongly justify the importance of testing the hypotheses.
4. Justifications regarding the characteristics of the participants are also needed.
5. The authors should follow the writing style recommended by Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association sixth edition. For example, in the Measures section, scale endpoints should be indicated parenthetically: for example, "...5-point Likert-type scale (1 = *not at all expected* and 5 = *very strongly expected*)."
6. The authors also need to give an example of item for each scale, and evidences of reliability and construct validity of each of the scales.
7. Much more detail is needed for the procedure section, e.g., the data collection procedure, the ethical clearance procedure, did all contacted participants agreed to take part in the study, did the researchers offer any reward for the participants?
8. In the Discussion section, the authors should add the results of the study from the theoretical perspective that they used in the Introduction section, and explain the implications of the study.
