- 6. There was no section to discuss the data analysis procedure
- 7. The rsult section only enjoyed descritive statistics which puts the findings under question. The author is recommended to use inferential statistics too.
- 8. Discission section is mostly a summary opf findings while it should include critical thinking to compare and contrast the obtained findings with the results of the relevant/similar studioes done by aother authors and researchers. Moreover, the author should elaborate on potential reasons for the similarities and differences found between his/her own results and results obtained in other studies.
