

Review of: "Factors Influencing the Laptop Buying Behavior of Students in Vietnam"

- 1. Introduction: The authors have mentioned the motivation to do research on this topic. However, the research gap has not been clearly discussed. There are no citations to support the claims.
- 2. Theoretical framework and research hypothesis: Two main theories have been discussed which are TRA and TPB. At the end of the discussion, the authors highlighted the limitations of the theories. However, there is no suggestion on how to address these limitations.
- 3. Literature review: The authors need to discuss the connection between each independent variable and dependent variable. The discussion must be supported with evidence from previous studies. The existing support is not sufficient. Each identified independent variable must be related to the underlying theories: TRA and TPB.
- 4. Questionnaire design: The variables mentioned in this section do not reflect the actual variables studied. The authors must make sure that the correct variables were measured using the right items.
- 5. Data collection: More detailed information is required such as the way the authors collect the required data.
- 6. Evaluation of the reliability of the scale: Results of the reliability test should be presented after factor analysis.
- 7. Exploratory factor analysis: Just use the term factor analysis. If you use exploratory factor analysis you need to subsequently perform confirmatory factor analysis which is not done in your study. You were using multiple regression analysis to test the hypothesis.
- 8. The tables showing the correlation and multiple regression analysis results must be improved using the correct table format.
- 9. After the findings, the authors must discuss the findings and support the discussion with evidence from previous studies.
