- Clear and proper references should be made in the Materials and Methods. Under extraction, references should be provided for each extraction. For the analyses of the important phytochemical constituents, references should be made.
- Needs profoundly serious editing; personal pronouns should be avoided (e.g., we, our, etc.) Therefore, **we** aimed in this current study to conduct qualitative phytochemical analysis... (Introduction) To the best of **our** knowledge, this is the first report of this kind, especially *B. zeyheri*, collected in the Kingdom of Eswatini.....(Introduction) **We** (conclusion) concluded that various extracts obtained from the leaves and stem bark of *B. zeyheri*.....
- Table 1 is very explicit, so why Fig. 1 and 2?
- Analyses (plural), not analysis
- The conclusion should align with the title and the results in a precise manner.
- Overall, good work.
