A species of aerobic, Gram-negative, diplococci shaped bacteria assigned to the phylum Proteobacteria. This species is catalase and oxidase positive, nonmotile, colistinresistant, grows on chocolate agar in high humidity, and is characterized by its ability to produce acid from glucose, maltose, and lactose, as well as by its ability to produce betagalactosidase. N. lactamica is commensal in the human nasopharynx, commonly isolated from children, and is rarely pathogenic.
