

Review of: "Biliary Complications Following Liver Transplantation: The First Single-Center Tunisian Experience"

The article "Biliary Complications Following Liver Transplantation: The First Single-Center Tunisian Experience" describes a retrospective monocentric experience on biliary complications after liver transplantation. The article is well-written and describes early and late biliary complications and their relationship with statistically relevant risk factors. This study has a low number of patients (47) in about 20 years of experience, suggesting a center with little experience in transplantation, thus probably explaining a reported higher rate of biliary complications when confronted with the literature. As the number of patients grows, it would be interesting to see an improvement also in this kind of complication, which needs further studies. The discussion and conclusions are clear and on point.
