What type of knowledge are they referring to? Detection methods? Prevalence and concentration of specific pathogens? Spoilage mechanisms (as written in the abstract but not addressed)? Shelf-life?

Title: I do not see the current title suitable for the study based on your development. I would suggest: Microbiological quality and safety of commonly consumed vegetables: A review

Abstract: The objective of the study should be stated. What are the common vegetables you have addressed in your study?

Materials and Methods section is missing. How the literature review was performed?

Important issues: The authors should clearly make the difference between **food spoilage** and **food safety.** It is terrible mix in the current version of document. Also, the scientific names of the microorganisms should be in italics.

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
