## Citation

## Introduction and Problem Statement

- Lack of explanation on the statement of problem (research gap) that requires authors to conduct this study. Many statements are highlighted without any citations. Example: paragraph 1 – “It has become evident that e-guidance in education is emerging as a promising...”. Claiming something without any support.
- Why are you focusing on e-guidance professionals only?
- What is the main focus of this study? E-school counseling? E-orientation? Or e-guidance?

## Literature Review and Conceptual Framework

- The literature review is very important to look at the trend of previous studies as well as describing the direction/relation/effect between variables in the study. The author did not manage the explanation of the main variables – pandemic challenges – properly. Why do you focus on the evolution only?
- The literature review part does not provide the analysis of the overall articles reviewed. It is just article summaries.
- Hypotheses are not explained well in this part.

## Methodology

- What type of sampling technique are you applying in selecting the respondents? Why?
- Are you applying the “adopt and adapt” technique to all constructs and items?
- What are the “various activities undertaken” that relate to this study?
- Are you applying a mixed-method for this study? Or others? Why?

## Results and Discussion

- Overall, it is quite confusing to understand the way you manage this part. Hypotheses are not explained accordingly.

- Lack of explanation for each hypothesis.
