Title: Willingness-to-pay for Health Insurance: A Comparative Study between Formal and Informal Health-Workers

- This proposal approaches an interesting problem, the lack of access to health insurance faced by informal workers. The methodology suggested is correct and adequate. Yet, I can offer a few observations:
- At the beginning, the author describes the size of the informal sector and access to health but says nothing about the size of the informal sector in the specific field to be studied. Since the study is limited to formal and informal workers in the health field, something should be said about the size of the informality in this sector.
- Revise the selection criteria for formal workers: They are included if working for over a year but excluded if working for more than six months, which excludes those working for over a year. Also revise the selection criteria for informal workers.
- Considering that participants will face four possible outcomes, you may consider a multinomial logit/ probit model.
