You have made a great effort in sampling, collecting data, and classifying it into tables.

I appreciate that, but I have some comments:

- Firstly, I think that "the work" has no meaning and should be deleted, and the word "Economic" is repeated.
- Secondly, the methodology isn't clear.
- The method is not clarified well; you should talk about the model requirements, performance, and steps. As the paper is in English, the legend and labels of the figures should be in English too. But the most important thing about the figure is to delineate the shoreline, by showing it as a shapefile or by converting the legend to classes and showing the class of 0 meters, or maybe from 0 to -1.
- I don't have remarks about the "Research Results and Discussion"; it is clear and well written, but in Table 3.2, I don't understand what is meant by "She's limited"?
- In Table 3.3, you didn't state on what basis the level of vulnerability was classified.
- Finally, you haven't studied climate change. You talked about how climate conditions affect people and their livelihoods. To discuss climate change, you should compare current climate conditions with those 10 or 20 years ago. So I think your paper is related to natural hazards more than climate change. Therefore, the title of the research should be:
